# **STORAGE / PREP**

## Approved containers:

• Commercial sharps disposal container on sale at most pharmacies



• A properly labeled, <u>heavy</u> plastic detergent or bleach bottle with a screw-on cap for tight sealing



#### Unacceptable containers:

Steel cans (i.e. coffee); Glass bottles or jars; Aluminum cans; Plastic tubs, buckets, milk jugs, soda bottles or bags

#### Procedures:

Do NOT separate the needle from the syringe. Use a black permanent marker to label the container with "**bio-hazard**" or "**sharps**".

Collection programs can vary by location and are subject to change. Please call ahead for updates and to verify details.



## SAFE DISPOSAL IS IMPORTANT

Sharps (needles, syringes, and lancets) that are not properly handled or are improperly discarded can pose a health risk of infections and diseases to family members, sanitation and recycling workers, and others who may be accidentally stuck by them.

## <u>Sharps must be disposed</u> of separately from regular trash or recyclables.

The MCSWD and participating pharmacies provide safe disposal for residents using sharps at home.
